FY 2024 Services

- Laurel House, Inc. provided services to **920 individuals**.
- Counselors meet with program participants in-person, at the Resource Center and in the community, and also offer sessions virtually.
- **2,014 individuals** engaged with two rtor.org Resource Specialists for personalized response to requests. There were **2,079,890 user interactions*** on www.rtor.org.

FY 2024 Outcomes

Supported Education

- 126 participants: 24% in Associates; 21% in Bachelors; 17% in Vocational Certification; 8% in GED; 2% in Masters; 6% undecided; 22% in high school
- Onsite at college campuses and high schools

Supported Employment

- 142 participants with 66% competitively employed and 71% employed over 12 months

Mobile Employment Services (MES)

- 59 individuals with substance use disorders received onsite service at Recovery Houses

Thinking Well (Cognitive Remediation)

- 138 participants: 100% who completed sessions and took post-assessment achieved improvement in at least 1 of 5 domains; 91% in 2 domains; 72% in 3; 37% in 4 of 5; and 5% improved in all domains

Community Support Services and Housing

- 84 participants received support services and housing: case management and counseling in recovery planning, Activities of Daily Living (ADLs), and budgeting

Social Rehabilitation/Skill Building

- 796 individuals received services in: Writers', Artists', and Skill Building Workshops; Recovery planning, outreach, advocacy, peer support and wellness programs, including food delivery to participants
